FINANCIAL AID: WHERE THE MONEY RESIDE

Need-based aid is awarded based on a student's family's financial circumstances as documented on your FAFSA. **Merit-based aid** is awarded to students based on academics, athletics, artistic talent, volunteer services, and more!

SUBSIDIZED & UNSUBSIDIZED LOANS

Subsidized loans are loans where interest is paid by the federal government while you are in college. **Unsubsidized loans** begin accruing interest as soon as you accept the loan.

BREWING COLLEGE SAVINGS

Whether you're a freshman or senior, there are tons of ways for you to start saving for college now! Become a New Hampshire Scholar to be eligible for scholarships upon graduation. Take AP or Running Start courses to try and earn college credit. Seniors, consider living at home or renting your textbooks from your college or local library--photocopies of books will always cost more than purchasing a new book!
